3. First-Stage Audition for the advanced from the screenings

Monday May 18th 2020 starts at 11am^{*} *subject to change at Secion Suginami (1-22-32 Umezato, Suginami-ku, Tokyo) 5-minuites walk from Tokyo Metro Marunouchi Line, Higashi Koenji station, or 7-mituites walk from Shin Koenji station.

b) Orchestra Parts

*Orchestra Parts are mailed no later than one week prior to the audition date.

*Piano accompanist should be arranged by each candidate.

*The result will be mailed to each candidate.

4. Final Audition

Wednesday May 27th 2020 starts at 17:30^{*} *subject to change at Suginami Kokaido Hall (1-23-15 Kamiogi Suginami-ku Tokyo) 7-minutes walk from JR-East / Tokyo Metro Ogikubo station (north exit)

Orchestra Parts *Same pieces as the first-stage

5. Interview and Trial Period

The successful candidate will be interviewed after the final audition.

There is 4-month trial period after passing the final audition. Candidates are officially appointed once they acquire specified votes from all the orchestra members after their trial period ends.
